



## TERMS AND CONDITIONS – SITE RULES

Please take a few minutes to read the important information below. Upon booking or arriving on site, you agree to abide by the site rules and if found to be breaking these rules may be asked to leave.

### **Weekend Camping**

We will be offering onsite camping; all campsite pitches are pre-pay booked and paid online via our website shop. Camping costs £70 for the weekend. The pitches are 8m x 5m to ensure cars can fit on camping pitches, to meet with fire safety requirements. Maximum of two cars per camping pitch or one motorhome.

Entry to the campsite opens at 10.00am on Friday 26 August 2022, via Iford Lane, Bournemouth - postcode BH6 5NF. No access will be permitted prior to this time so if arriving early, please make other arrangements to park up away from the site.

All camping pitches must be vacated by midday on Monday 29 August 2022.

No parking or camping is allowed on the entry road - there is clear signage, any vehicles parking there will be reported and riders may be barred from racing. No late arrivals after 9pm.

Guests must produce their booking confirmation on arrival. You will be issued with a tag which is to be made visible on the vehicle for checks.

In the event of poor ground conditions a pitch may not be available. The Club will endeavour to advise the customer in advance should this occur but no responsibility can be accepted if this is not possible.

There are no electrical hook up points on site.

### **Parking**

Parking: one price of £10 for the weekend (26/27/28 August), one car per parking pass only. You will be asked to enter your vehicle registration when you purchase your parking pass.

Please display your car sticker in your vehicle window at all times.

Please follow the directions of the car parking stewards on arrival and park as requested.

The site speed limit is a strict 5mph

### **Friday Gate Practice**

Friday practice passes will be live to purchase on the club's website from midday on Monday 11 July 2022.

£6 per rider, details of practice times for different classes will be published in due course.

Please follow instructions from our volunteers at all times, in order to make the most of the practice session and keep everyone safe.

### **Gazebos**

Gazebo pitches must be booked and paid for in advance via Bournemouth BMX Club's website shop. Elite team pitches will be in the traders area and can be added to a trade stand (paid for separately).

Prices are as follows:

Elite teams: £40 3x3m

Regions are being allocated sufficient space for club gazebos, please contact your regional committee for more information. No charge.

No gazebos will be permitted trackside – an accessible area will be reserved for disabled access.



## Accessibility

The venue is flat and spectator areas enjoy step-free access. Disabled parking near to the track is available – please contact the club for details and please be prepared to show blue badges/equivalent. Commissaires will be able to park near to the track in designated areas. No other track side parking will be available.

## Refund, cancellation and amendment policy

Advance booking only for campsite pitches, parking, practice and gazebos.

Cancelling your booking: due to the short lead time, no refunds will be provided. Any unwanted pitches will need to be sold privately.

If you leave the site early for any reason we will keep any unused fees and you will not be entitled to a refund.

Sites with unsuitable camping conditions. If adverse circumstances, for example flooding, result in Bournemouth BMX Club cancelling your booking at any time, a full refund of your deposit or unused camping fees will be made.

## Fire safety

THE CAMP SITE AND TRACKSIDE AREAS ARE NO SMOKING AREAS. Please smoke outside of the trackside, camping and parking area, away from competitors.

Because of the danger of fire, open fires are not permitted on site. Barbecues within the campsite area may be lit provided they are purpose-built, portable and stand clear of the ground. There must be no possibility of damage to the ground. Only gas or charcoal barbecues should be used - no wood burners. Barbecues must be fully extinguished and cold before disposing of ash in the bins provided. Barbecues are not permitted anywhere else at the venue.

There will be fire points situated around the site; if there is a fire please ring the bell at the fire point to alert other campers or spectators and make your way to the nearest emergency exit point. In the event of an emergency please call 999. Site address Iford Lane, Bournemouth BH6 5NF.

## Campsite

Upon arrival you will be shown to your pitch – pitches are 8m x 5m. You may reserve space for fellow campers, however please ensure you leave as much space as possible between yourself and your neighbour. Please do not move or adjust any markers that are laid out to allocate pitch space.

The fire assembly points will be clearly marked within the campsite, on arrival please familiarise yourself with the campsites fire regulations, firefighting equipment and its location as soon as possible.

For safety reasons do not park your vehicle directly in front of your tent entrance.

Please, please, please ensure you remove ALL PEGS from tents/awnings etc when you leave. The rugby pitches will be back in use following the event, it is essential that no pegs are left behind.

## Gazebos and generators

Gazebos are permitted but must be erected according to manufacturer's instructions and weighted appropriately for any inclement weather conditions.

Generators may be used, we may ask you to refrain from using them if they cause a disturbance. Please ensure they are fenced off and not accessible to the general public. For fire safety, it is essential that any fuel is kept in the correct container for its content and that it is kept locked away and out of direct sunlight.

Generators must be switched off after dark at the latest.

## Pets

Dogs are welcome but please keep them on a lead and ensure you clear up immediately using the bins provided around the field. Please keep dogs away from the trackside spectator area.



## Access

The venue will close at 23:00 for vehicle access on Friday, Saturday and Sunday night and will re-open at 07:00. There is NO overnight parking outside of the campsite area.

Vehicle movements on the venue are to be kept to a minimum, vehicle movements will not be permitted from 23:00 - 07:00 across the site including camping and car parking areas on Friday, Saturday and Sunday. Vehicle access & egress will be maintained at all times for emergency purposes.

All vehicles must not exceed the strict site speed limit of 5 mph (walking pace) at all times.

Please be aware that the venue and campsite sits adjacent to a river, it is the responsibility of parents and guardians to ensure children are supervised at all times, whilst on site.

## Venue Facilities

There are no washing up facilities on site, but there will be facilities for waste water disposal.

There will be designated toilets for campsite pitches. Other event toilets and showers are available across the site. Toilets and showers will be inspected and serviced daily.

Onsite catering will be available from 12:00 - 21:00 on Friday and 07:00 - 21:00 on Saturday and Sunday from 07:00 - 10:00 Monday.

An onsite bar will be available from Midday - 23:00, Friday, Saturday and Sunday.

There will be music on Friday evening, Saturday evening and Sunday evening.

## Noise

As the campsite is temporary and the venue is in a residential area, please keep the noise to a level which will not disturb local residents or other site users, especially between the hours of 22:30 and 07:00.

Between the hours of 22:30 and 07:00 all music, lighting and generators must be turned off within the vicinity of the campsite.

## Water

Fresh water will be available from the marked water point - please ask Stewards to direct you.

Competitors will be able to refill water bottles at the refill point, a small donation is requested for flavoured squash/cordial. No single use plastic bottles of water will be available for sale on site.

## Rubbish

Please do not drop litter in the campsite or venue, please place all litter in the rubbish or recycling bins provided. Campers must clear all items from their pitch before departure. Please be considerate when leaving the site. Please take any unwanted and broken items away with you to dispose of at home. Please collect your household rubbish in the black bag provided and when leaving place in the bins provided, or take it home with you. Please only put recyclable items in the recycling bins.

## Strictly prohibited

The following are not permitted anywhere at the venue or campsite area: campfires, fireworks, chinese lanterns, kites or drones.

## Waste prevention and recycling

Please collect recyclables separately and use the recycling points provided.

Please bring your own mugs with you for hot drinks to help us reduce waste.

For cold drinks, we will operate a reusable cup deposit scheme. We ask that you use this responsibly, returning cups to be rinsed and reused; if you want to keep a cup, please do so at the end of Sunday to help us manage the event. If you want your £2 deposit back, just take your cup back.



## Security

All items and property brought into the venue including the campsite, gazebos and car park remain the sole responsibility and sole risk of the customer and their guests.

Bournemouth BMX Club/BCP Council accept no responsibility whatsoever for loss or damage to persons or property including, motor vehicles and personal effects, howsoever caused or sustained arising out of the use of the site or its facilities.

All visitors must comply with all reasonable directions from event staff, security and stewards. We expect all our stewards to be treated with respect during your time on our site. If anyone in your group is disrespectful, abusive or threatening, your group will be asked to leave the site and riders may be barred from racing.

There will be 24-hour security on site. Please ensure your valuables are secure at all times; if you see anyone acting suspiciously please report this to the security staff or a club volunteer.

If you need to contact anyone during the weekend, please speak with the onsite security team directly or one of our volunteers. You and your party's property remain on the campsite, in gazebos and the car park at your own risk.

## The track

The track is closed from 0800 Friday morning for maintenance, coaching and practice, and thereafter closed for racing throughout the weekend. The track will be closed at various points in the week prior to the event and a timetable will be published on the club website. The track will reopen to the public on Monday afternoon once safe to do so, following event breakdown.

Anyone found to be riding on the track when it is closed to the public will be asked to leave the site and may be barred from racing.

## Accident and emergency

The nearest accident and emergency department is Royal Bournemouth Hospital, Castle Lane East, Bournemouth BH7 7DW. The hospital is a five-minute drive from the campsite and track.
